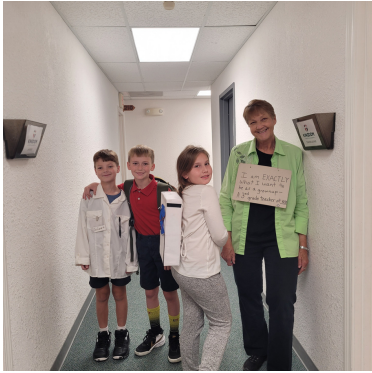

## Who is the Monster: Shark or Cow

The odds of getting attacked by a shark are low compared to other death causing events. You have a 1 in 3.75 billion chance of dying due to a shark attack, yet you have a 1 in 84 chance of dying due to a car accident. Every year, 10 people die from getting attacked by a shark, yet 100 people die every year due to getting stepped on by a cow. A director of the National Shark Attack Files claimed that, "It's pretty unusual in that part of the world." (Talking about the Red Sea attack.) Do you have the same kind of fear about cows that you do sharks, let's talk about that.

Sharks are only "mindless killers" because of the publicity of every attack. If there was publicity every time a person died from mosquitoes, you would be afraid to go outside. Former director of the I.S.A.F. George H. Burgess told Live Science, "they are just animals living in their environment-were the invaders." Sharks have only been known to attack when they are confused or curious. Lots of attacks happen in the dusk or dawn, which is why lots of beaches are closed during those times. Some people think sharks are ruthless killers, and here is why.

The idea that sharks can hold a grudge is with "evidence." Sharks can smell human body fluid a mile away. Sharks will fight to kill if they think they can win. Sharks are known as silent killers because they only attack if the target is alone. Some say that sharks are mindless killers. But the odds of getting attacked are very slim. This does not mean that attacks do not happen nor that it is not horrific when it does happen, like the Red Sea incident. We have to remember that we are the invaders, That they are just animals in their natural environment.

### Original Steering Committee

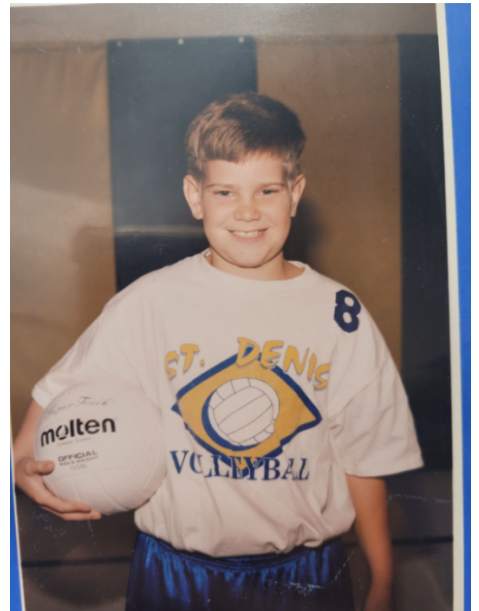

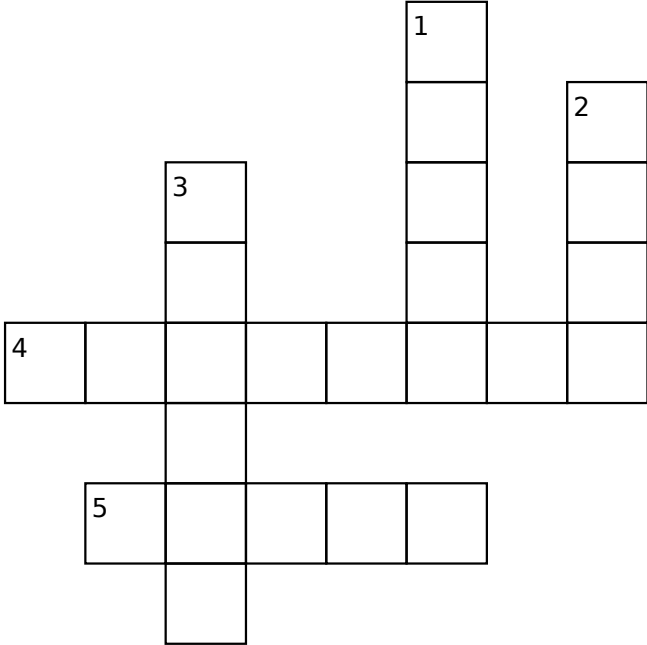
