#### **KCA Illness Policy**

If a child has been ill during the night or becomes ill upon awakening, they should not be sent to school. This will help prevent spread of illnesses among other students and teachers.

#### Illness

If a child experiences any of the following symptoms, please do not send them to school:

- Fever of 100°F or more.
- Persistent cough or severely runny nose unrelated to allergies.
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.







If a child becomes ill or has a temperature of 100°F or more during the school day, the parent or designee will be contacted to pick up the student. The child should be fever-free for 24 hours without medication before being returned to school. KCA reserves the right to refuse the attendance of any ill child.
