 - For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost. Luke 19:10 NIV
- All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23 NIV.
 - Who is exempt from sin? NO ONE!
- Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers a multitude of sins. 1 Peter 4:8.
 - Get over yourself. Go make things right to the best of your ability. Coming to your senses and choosing to love others deeply are the first steps in restoring broken relationships.
- For we are each responsible for our own conduct. Galatians 6:5.
 - We have to overcome one nasty obstacle: PRIDE. (Pride is defined as ARROGANCE, SELF-LOVE, CONCEIT, & VANITY) Humility is the opposite of pride. It is noble. Putting your rights aside for the greater good of others.
- So he returned home to his father. While he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him. *Luke 15:20.*
 - Run to people! Love them with abandon. Run, because love matters! Be like the father in the Prodigal Son, not the older brother. Forgive quickly and enjoy the party.
